The appropriate and proper Miami-Dade County election officials shall conduct said General Election hereby called, with acceptance of the certification of the results of said General Election to be performed by the City Commission. The official returns for each precinct shall be furnished to the City Clerk of the City of Miami Beach as soon as the ballots from all precincts have been tabulated.

The voting precincts in the City for said General Election shall be as established by the proper and appropriate Miami-Dade County Elections Officials. On Election Day, all electors shall vote at the polling places and the voting precincts in which the official registration books show that the said electors reside. All questions concerning polling places and voting precincts should be directed to the Miami-Dade County Elections Department, 2700 NW 87 Avenue, Doral, Florida 33172; Telephone: 305.499.VOTE (8683) or 305.499.8480 TTY.

Registration of persons desiring to vote in the General Election shall be in accordance with the general law of the State of Florida governing voter registration. Qualified persons may obtain registration forms to vote at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 1700 Convention Center Drive, First Floor, Miami Beach, Florida 33139, during normal business hours, and at such other voter registration centers and during such times as may be provided by the Supervisor of Elections of Miami-Dade County. Each person desiring to become a registered voter shall be responsible for properly filling out the registration form and returning it to the Miami-Dade County Elections Department. The voter registration deadline for the November 5, 2013 General Election is the close of business on Monday, **October 7, 2013**. Absentee voters participating in said General Election shall be entitled to cast their ballots in accordance with the provisions of the Laws of the State of Florida with respect to absentee voting.
