

Motion Text:

*The Budget Advisory Committee recommends the Mayor and City Commission to approve the proposed increase to the City's golf rates for FY 2014/15 totaling approximately \$350,000, with the direction that there should be no increase to the resident rate at Normandy Shores Golf Course and that other rates at both of the City's golf courses be adjusted to make up the difference in revenue.*

Motion seconded by Ronald Starkman

Motion Text:

*The Budget Advisory Committee recommends the Mayor and City Commission to allow the management company the ability to adjust pricing based on demand as follows:*

*--Normandy Shores Golf Course up or down, but the resident rate can only go down, not up*

*--Miami Beach Golf Course up, except for the resident rate which can only remain flat.*

The Budget Advisory Committee urges the Mayor and Commission to support the above request.
