SUBJECT: **FDOT Alton Road Project Update**

The purpose of this Letter to Commission is to inform you of a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) update for the Alton Road, 5th street to Michigan Avenue Construction Project.

On the night of Sunday, October 12th, the contractor is planning on implementing a traffic control plan (see attached) that will close off 17th Street from the center of Alton Road to the east for a distance of approximately 150 feet. This closure is needed to install drainage and reconstruct the roadway at this location, similar to what was done a few months back on the west side.

In order to perform this work, no vehicular travel will be permitted east or west along 17th Street, from the center of Alton Road to the east. Detours shall be set up at Meridian Avenue for west bound lanes and at 17th/Dade Boulevard for east bound lanes. Along Alton Road, north bound and south bound travel lanes will need to be reduced to a single lane on the approach to 17th Street in both directions. This closure will last approximately seven days.
