SUBJECT: **Miami Beach Police Department Assignment of 41st Street Beat Officers**

The purpose of this Letter to Commission (LTC) is to inform the Mayor and Commission of the recent assignment of two 41st Street Beat Officers on November 17, 2014. This effort was part of Chief Oates' plan to reorganize the Department and effectively deploy police resources in the community.

In the spirit of Community Policing, the purpose of these assignments are to strengthen community partnerships along the 41st Street business district, provide crime prevention tips, add visibility and safety in and around North Beach and Nautilus Elementary Schools and reduce the incidence of crime. Their area of patrol activities will for the first time broaden out to the boardwalk along the beach for the very same purpose. Officers will be deployed on foot, Segway's, ATV's, police golf carts and when necessary, in patrol cars. Their work hours are from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
