SUBJECT: **FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT), STATE ROAD (SR)
907 ALTON ROAD PROJECT LANE CLOSURE**

The purpose of this Letter to Commission is to provide information on an upcoming Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Alton Road Project, lane closure. Bergeron has advised that in order to complete the drainage crossing of West Avenue at 5th Street and maintain the West Ave southbound left turn to 5 Street westbound, they will need to close the outside 5th Street westbound lane. This will allow their crews to work on the western portion of the crossing and shift West Avenue southbound traffic further east to make the right turn onto 5th Street. As such, they will temporarily remove the delineators that were installed by the City of Miami Beach. Although it is feasible that this work be performed at a later time, it is logical that it be performed now as part of the ongoing operations and in the effort to expedite completion of the 5th Street Pump Station. The FDOT Project Manager has approved the lane closure for **tomorrow, Wednesday, June 9th, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** and apologizes for the extreme short notice but believes it is critical that this work be completed as soon as possible and that this is the most effective and quickest way.

The westbound lane will be closed east of Alton Road. There will be one turn lane closed from northbound Alton Road to westbound 5th Street.
